Valid documentation

Driving licence and vehicle rental agreement



Insurance

If you're caught driving a vehicle you're not insured to drive, you'll receive a £300 fine and six points on your licence.

Penalties could be higher, including disqualification, if the case goes to court.



Valid MOT certificate



112 is the European emergency number





Motorways

*Where there is a derestricted zone, marked by a white circle with a diagonal black stripe.



Dual carriageways

*Where there is a derestricted zone, marked by a white circle with a black stripe.

Under section 51 of the Hackney Carriage Act 1831, all London taxi drivers were required by law to carry oats and a bale of hay.



Always remember to drive on the left

In the UK, you drive on the left side of the road and the driver sits on the right hand side of the car.

Be aware of speed limits

Speed limits are set in miles per hour, rather than kilometres per hour.

Be aware of variable motorway rules

Parts of the UK operate managed motorway systems, which control traffic-flow during congested periods by varying speed limits and opening up hard shoulders.

Watch out for puffin and equestrian crossings

These crossings for pedestrians and horses can be found in the countryside.

Stop for adequate rest-breaks

There's no excuse not to. The UK has around 100 service stations.

Don'ts

Allow children under 12 to sit in the front seat

It is against the law for children under 12 to sit in the front unless they're in booster seats.

Worry about keeping spare change on you

The UK only has one toll road - a section of the M6, from Birmingham to Wolverhampton.


Drive into central London without checking where the congestion zone is
